February Board Notes

The board met February 2 with 8 members attending.

♦ *Treasurer's report:* current balances include: \$3,204 in the Admin account, and \$14,274 in the Service account, for a total of \$17,478.

♦ *Westfield Key Club:* John Woods had reported that 9 club members are planning to attend the April Key Club district convention. Our board approved \$1,000, which represents 1/3 of the cost for attendance.

♦ *Our scout troop:* \$300 was approved to help pay for one of the scouts (with special needs) to attend this year's summer camp.

♦ *Trailer for farmers market equipment:* This has been discussed at several recent board meetings. We have found it necessary to discontinue storing our equipment and supplies in the trailer that is supplied by the market for storing equipment each week. After pursuing a number of possibilities, Connie Hunt uncovered the availability of a good-quality, used 8' trailer on the southside of Indianapolis, at a price of \$1,200. Jerry Jacobson and Dick Klar will be following up this week to see if it will take care of our needs.

♦ *New division project in Sycamore South:* Referring to the January issue of the Hoosier Kiwanian, the Carmel Golden K club has been collecting "gently used" shoes to be included in shipments to Afghanistan. They have gathered up 300 to 400 pairs monthly, and forwarded them to the Changing Footprints site for sorting and packaging.

This project is now being expanded to all of the Sycamore South clubs, so now is the time for everyone to go through their closets and see how many pairs of still-usable shoes can be re-cycled for use in this worthwhile project.

Here are the instructions:

Tie the shoestrings to together so they don't become separated. If they don't have laces, put them in a small plastic bag using twist-ties, and bring them to any Monday morning meeting, where they can be stored in our supply closet. Since the Golden K club has a regular system in place for getting shoes to their intended pick-up point, we will see that our shoes are forwarded to them for processing.

This project was approved by our board at Monday's meeting.
