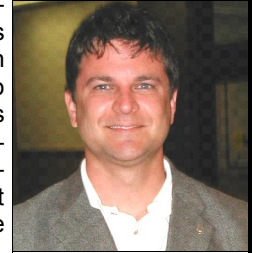
Car Wash Coupons: Flyers for the Mike's Express Car Wash fundraiser will be coming in late August for our fundraiser in September.

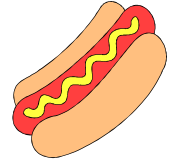

Ground Rules for Operating Farmers Market

Brenda Cook shared with us some valuable information regarding the proper operation of the food booth at Farmers Market. We all need to be fully aware of the need to follow proper procedures so as to avoid possible eviction!



The booth takes four people to run. At least one member from our old club should be there every week to help everyone get "trained." We have to be very careful not to cross-contaminate, so the person taking money only takes money, the person cooking eggs only cooks eggs, etc.

We have plastic gloves to use, we just need to make sure we don't wear them outside the booth or handle money then food with them on. Since we are a not-for-profit we really don't have to follow the Health Dept. rules; however, the Market staff and others are watching.

One thing to be sure to tell everyone is that we can NOT clean up early. Our group was cautioned last week not to start cleaning up until 11:31! We don't want to get kicked out of the market, so we have to follow their rules.
